

- Work done **only** as a college student is eligible to enter.
- No entry fees!
- None of the submissions should be older than **3 years** i.e. they should be done **AFTER September 2016**.
- A maximum of **3 entries per individual** / group is allowed.
- Each entry has to be filled with a separate entry form. All the information should be authentic and validated by School authority or equivalent.
- Last date of submission is **OCTOBER 31, 2019**.
- No Copyright-Infringing Material: This is an important aspect, and entries will get eliminated automatically if they use any material deemed as such.
- We accepting entries in the form of an archive format (.rar/.zip) which is categorized and sorted.
- The entries will undergo primary evaluation and the list of selected entries shall be uploaded to the official website.
- Jury's decision will be final and will **NOT** be breached.
- NID, Andhra Pradesh will have the right to change, modify or cancel the festival schedule without any prior notice due to unavoidable circumstances, if any.
- NID Andhra Pradesh will include the selected entries to its archive and may use the same for any academic & promotional activities with due acknowledgment.
- Chitrakatha is a Design Olympic that believes in using resources creatively, while keeping in touch with social, political and environmental issues and solving them. We believe in "Less is More" in terms of the resources we use, and rely on creativity and love to do the rest.
